Area Runners Without Title In Champions Track Meet

KALAMAZOO — Top area performers in the Champion of Champions meet Monday at Western Michigan University track were Hartford's Vere Shindeldecker and Paw Paw's Bob Crocker.

Shindeldecker was third in both sprints with a 10.1 clocking in the 100-yard dash and a 22.4 reading in the 220.

Crocker was also third with a 1:57 flat in his 880-yard run specialty.

St. Joe's Mike Miller and

Mike Johnson were the only other area thinclads to place.

Miller was fourth in the 440-yard dash at 50.2, while Johnson took two fifth places with a long jump leap of 21'8½" and a low hurdles time of 19.6 seconds.

Pontiac Central's Bill Tipton was named the meet's outstanding performer after he set a record with an 18.9 time in the low hurdles. He also had a

winning 14.2 in the high hurdles.

Four other records also fell at Flint Southwestern's Laverne Miller got off a leap in the long jump of 23'7"; Farmington's Ron Shortt went 13'10" in the pole vault; Roseville's Bill Wehrweir finished the 440 in 49.4, and Dearborn Heights Riverside's Rich Stevens was clocked at 1:53.7 in the half mile.
