Pershing E. Side Track Champion

Pershing sacrificed a state championship relay quartet to put away the City League's East Side track title Thursday.

The Doughboys edged Eastern, 76-69 1/2, winning events with sophomore Elliott Hastings (100) and seniors Andre Broadnax (440), Dennis Baker (1,100) and John Kitchen (800).

But the Pershing foursome of Broadnax, Kitchen, Dale Hardean and Reginald Bradford got beat in the mile relay by Southeastern in a time that was four seconds slower than their state record of 3:21.6.

"THEY WERE tired," said coach John Telford. "We wanted the team championship so I doubled them up in other events rather than keeping them fresh for the relay."

"Then Bradford got his heel stepped on in the baton exchange and lost a shoe and ran all the way with one foot bare."

Law Hits Homer to Beat Mets

NEW YORK —(UPI)— Vern Law hurled his fourth straight shutout over the New York Mets in two years and hit one of three Pittsburgh home runs Thursday night to pace the Pirates to 5-0 victory.

Donn Clendenon and Willie Stargell also homered as the Pirates collected 10 hits in handing the Mets their third straight loss.

Law, who blanked the Mets three times in as many appearances against them last season, yielded only three singles, two by Cleon Jones, for his second victory in four decisions.

Clendenon broke a scoreless struggle between Law and southpaw Rob Gardner with a homer in the sixth. Law hit his homer in the seventh. Stargell connected for his sixth homer in the ninth when the Pirates added their final three runs.
