Stag Sprint Star 'Beats the Clock'

Charles Robinson came out running Friday as the closest thing to Henry Carr since the Olympian-to-be was doing his high school running here.

A junior just transferred into Mackenzie this year from Florida, Robinson streaked the 100-yard dash in 9.7 seconds and the 220 in 20.7.

The times missed Carr's city records by one-tenth second in each event.

Robinson's running helped Mackenzie give Northwestern a run for the City League's West Side championship before the Colts won out with 78 points against Mackenzie's 70.

Double winners besides Robinson were Northwestern's Henry Reed in the shot put and high jump and Cass Tech's Ira Russell in the hurdles.
