

'Francie' Earns High Placings

BERKELEY, Calif. — Ann Arbor's **F r a n c i e** **K r a k e r** turned in the finest 800-meter time of her career here yesterday to edge-out highly-touted **M a r i e** **M u l d e r** and gain third place in the All-American Track and Field Invitational.

Miss **K r a k e r**, a sophomore at Michigan, bettered her best previous time by 3½ seconds with a 2:07.4 clocking while **M a r i e** **M u l d e r**, who had defeated the Ann Arbor speedster in their previous meetings was fourth in 2:12 flat.

C h a r l o t t e **C o o k** of California won the event in 2:05 flat.

Miss **K r a k e r**, who now joins the ranks of International class runners, also ran Saturday, turning in a :56.4 to finish among the top four women in a quarter-mile event.
