"Of all the girls in the U.S.A., I think Francie has the greatest potential for the 1968 Olympics," commented Ken Simmons, coach of the Southeastern Michigammes, following Francie Kraker's outstanding effort in the 880-yard run at the Los Angeles International Games last weekend.

Miss Kraker, a sophomore at Michigan, placed fifth in the event against the top women athletes from the British Commonwealth while American Charlotte Cooke of Los Angeles won the half-mile event in 2:04.6.
