

Francie Kraker Places Third

TORONTO, Ont. — Ann Arbor's Francie Kraker, who has been setting records right and left, had to settle for third place in the 880-yard run in the 10th Maple Leaf Indoor Games.

Miss Kraker led for the first four laps but Abby Hoffman, who was running before home-town fans, took the lead. She

went on to win with a 2:10.4 clocking.

Madeline Manning of Tennessee State and Miss Kraker raced together for the rest of the distance, but Miss Manning was able to edge the Michigan game for second with a 2:12.4 time.

Miss Kraker was timed in 2:12.6.
