Miss Kraker Wins Event In Canada

Continuing her winning ways as is Ann Arbor's Francie Kraker, B who captured the women's 880-to yard run in the Highland Indoor Meet at Hamilton, Ont.

Miss Kraker was clocked in 2:15.3 to break the meet record by almost two seconds. The old brecord was held by Roberta Picco of Toronto at 2:17.1 and was set last year.

During the meet, Ray Tucker, is a 20-year McMaster University he freshman, emerged as Canada's strongest threat in the middle distance events.

Tucker streaked to an impressive victory in the 1,000-yard a
run. His victory was over a
strong field, but it did not include Bill Brothers, who was
sidelined with an injured foot.

Bob Findlay of Toronto won the mile in 4:10.5 over John Fath of Fordham, Pete Buniak of Toronto was the two-mile winner, defeating Michigan State's Dick Sharkey.
