

Union City Wins Its Own Relays

UNION CITY — Union City placed in seven of 12 events, including four first place finishes to win its own Second Annual Union City Relays here Saturday before 1,000 spectators. Twenty-two schools entered teams.

The UC trackmen tallied 64 points while runner-up Napoleon scored 56, Constantine 45 and defending champion Galesburg-Augusta 29.

Eleven of the 12 meet records established in the first running last year were broken with only the 100-yard dash remaining intact.

Union City won two of the four field events with Doug Miller and Dennis Kaniewski teaming to win the high jump and Warren Converse and Dale Enyart combining to take the shot put. Union City's two mile relay team of Dave Brandt, Eric Tundevold, Jeff Aldrich and Mark Aldrich grabbed a first place medal as did the one mile relay of Tundevold, Miller, Brandt and Mark Aldrich.

Hillsdale Divides 2 With Flint JC

HILLSDALE — UPI — Dwayne Peiz's two-run homer in the sixth led Hillsdale College to a 6-2 baseball victory over Flint Junior College Saturday.

Flint came back in the second game of the doubleheader to take a 5-0 win, behind the three-hit pitching of Tim Jarvi.

Peiz's homer came in Hillsdale's big four-run sixth inning of the opener. It scored Mike Harding from second. Harding knocked in Mel Banks and Paul Bongiovanni with his double, to break a 2-2 tie.

In the second game, Jarvi allowed a double and two singles.

Napoleon placed first in the pole vault, shuttle hurdle and Union City relays, also taking two second places and one fourth. Defending champion G-A also scored in six events, managing two seconds, two fourths and two fifth place finishes.

In individual entries, Pete Hubbard of Grass Lake ran the mile in 4:45.0 to take a first while Dick Scott of Constantine won the 100 yard dash in :10.55 but failed to lower the meet record.
