Ann Arbor High Deals Shock To Ypsilanti

The Six-A League track championship will go on the line Wednesday night when two regional champions, Ann Arbor High and Battle Creek Central, clash in the conference meet at Post Field in Battle Creek.

In their weekend regions, a couple of hands were played according to Jacoby and a couple were not. As expected, the Battle Creek Bearcats grandly slammed their regional Kalamazoo's Maroon Giants bid successfully for runner-up honors.

What wasn't expected, how-

ever, was for Ann Arbor High to trump the team that had not only beaten them for the regional title a year ago but one that had also downed them in dual meet competition earlier this year—powerful Ypsilanti.

But that's just what the Pioneers did with a total of 52 points in the Class A regional here Saturday.

For Jim Love's Purple and White it was a soaring victory and certainly there was no greater soarer on the field than Larry Robards, new holder of the Ann Arbor High and regional pole vault records. Based upon his tremendous regional showing, Robards might reasonably be expected to be one of the top contenders in next weekend's state meet at East Lan-

The slender blonde senior's victory in the pole vault earned six of the Pioneers' 18 field event points that enabled the Purple and White to erase Ypsilanti's 36-34 advantage in the running events.

The victory avenged last year's 49-47½ regional defeat by the Braves and reversed a 62½-55½ dual meet loss earlier this season.

In addition to Robards' mark, the winner of the new two-mile distance run, Detroit Redford Union's Jack Shepard and Pioneer miler Brent Stone also entered the Regional record book.
