#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

(Contestants and Coaches)

- 1. REGISTRATION—Headquarters will be located in the Information Office under the west stand of the stadium. Contestants' numbers, pins and programs will be issued at the stadium,
- 2. DRESSING ROOM—All teams will dress in the locker rooms under the west stands at the stadium. It will be necessary to double up in the assigned lockers. Attendants will open the lockers.
- 3. VALUABLES—Bring one lock for locker for valuables.
- 4. TOWELS—Use own towels.
- 5. MEALS—SCHOOLS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN MEALS AND LODGING. Meals may be obtained at the Union Cafeteria or any of the East Lansing restaurants.
- 6. DRAWINGS—Heat leaders will be placed according to the records made in the Regional Meets. Drawing for lanes in the dashes and hurdles will be made previous to the start of the meet. Positions in the distance races will be drawn at the start of the race. THERE WILL BE NO COACHES' MEETINGS.
  - Bull Pen located at south end of field. All athletes entered in heats of 440 yard dash, 880 yard run, one mile run, 2 mile and all relays, report for assignment upon 1st call of your event.
- 7. WEIGHT MEN—Have your shot checked for weight and size at the shot put ring.
- 8. TRAINING—Trainers will be available on the field during the meet.
- 9. Coaches and Trainers must stay in the stands during the meet. Contestants must keep out of the infield area unless actually competing in the field events.
- 10. TIME SCHEDULE—Events will be run according to the schedule on Front Page of this program. There will be no calls made, SO BE READY. Be warmed up and ready to go on scheduled time. Dash and hurdle men can warm up on the East Straightaway.
- 11. TRACK EVENTS—All track events of 440 yards or more will be run from the center of the straightaway.
- 12. RELAY EVENTS—Both relays will be run around the track. In the 880 relay the first 220 leg is to be run in lanes from staggered starts. The number two runner will receive the baton from the number one runner in the same lane in which the latter started; thereafter, "At each station, each competitor shall line up in the same relative position as that for his teammate who starts the race but there may be movement to a position best suited to meeting the passer of the baton. Each passer will keep a straight course to the exchange zone and the burden of responsibility for taking the position which corresponds to that to which the passer is entitled is on the receiver. This permits a team which has a distance lead throughout the race to make all exchanges in the pole position."

The One Mile Relay is to be run from staggered starts around the first turn; Thereafter, lanes are to be disregarded and the baton exchange is to be made in accordance with the above quotation.

- 13. SCORING—Individual Events—First 8; Second 7; Third 6; Fourth 5; Fifth 4; Sixth 3; Seventh 2; Eighth 1. Relays—First 10; Second 9; Third 8; Fourth 7; Fifth 6; Sixth 5; Seventh 4; Eighth 3; Ninth 2; Tenth 1.
- 14. PRIZES—Trophies for the winner and runner-up in the meet and winner of each relay in each class. Medals for the point winners in each event in each class. In case of ties, the State Association will attempt to provide duplicate awards. Winners will please sign up for their awards immediately following each event. The custodians of prizes will be located in the tent at the north turn of the track.
