

Brother Rice, U-D Share Track Title

Brother Rice and U-D High, who have dominated Catholic League track the past three seasons, shared the title Tuesday in the annual championships at Redford High.

Brother Rice came from behind to win the mile relay, final event on the program, to finish with 43 points the same total piled up by the Cubs.

Rick Barnabo of Catholic Central set a record of 9.9 seconds in the 100-yard dash. The only other record went to U-D who came up with a 1:31.1 effort in the 880-yard relay.

One of the day's top performances was a 1:58.8 half-mile by Brother Rice's Doub Bair.
