

U-D High, Rice Share Title in Catholic League Track

Relay depth enabled defending champion Brother Rice and U. of D. High to share the Catholic League's First Division track championship yesterday at Redford High field.

With U-D and Catholic Central sharing the lead at 39 points each and Brother Rice trailing with 37 going into the final event, the mile relay, Rice and U-D finished 1-2 to wind up tied at 43 points apiece.

The Rice foursome of Lou Ciarvarella, John Keating, Tim Branigan and Doug Bair was clocked in 3:30.4 to U-D's 3:31.6. Catholic Central was fifth.

The relay victory was worth six points to Brother Rice. U-D picked up four points. Catholic-Central gained only one point to take third place on 40 points. Notre Dame was fourth on 34.

"This is the first time we've ever had cochampions in the 20-year history of Catholic League track competition," said director Ralph Owen.

U-D WON THE league title two years ago, in 1965, and Rice won last season.

U-D won the 880 relay in a record 1:31.1. The members of the team John Tenbusch's foursome were John Gillis, Roger Curley, Dave Wessner and Paul Wessner.

Gillis also won the 440

title with a clocking of 50.6 seconds.

U-D and Brother Rice each won four events. U-D's other individual winners were Jerry Myszkowski in the mile (4:28.9) and Joe Hart in the long jump (21 feet 7).

RICE HURDLER Tom Masson was one of two double winners in the meet. He took the lows in 20.3 and the highs in 15.4. Teammate Doug Bair also won the 880 in 1:58.8. The other individual double victory was achieved by Catholic Central sprinter Rick Barnabo, who was timed in a record 9.9 for the 100. He won the 220 in 22.1.

Catholic Central posted a 1-2 finish in the shot put as Frank Gerbig hit 54 feet, 3 inches and Tom Wood went 51 feet 8 3/4.

The two-mile run, a new event for state high schools, was won by Bishop Gallagher's Joe Grajek in 9:46.7.

Bishop Gallagher and Cathedral both made impressive efforts in reaching double scoring digits with 12 and 10 points for fifth and sixth positions, respectively. Cathedral's Larry Tyler won the high jump at 6 feet and the meet's other winner was Notre Dame pole vaulter Dave Reis (12 feet).
