

# St. Charles Takes 2nd Track Crown

Al Henderson, Alfred Jones and Jeff Sinclair each won two events as St. Charles captured its first Catholic League Second Division track title yesterday at Brother Rice High School field.

Henderson took the 440 in 52.3 seconds and long-jumped 21 feet, 3 1/4 inches, Jones won the 100 in a record 10:01.5 and the 220 in 23.0, and Sinclair was timed in a record 22.0 and 16.8 for the low and high hurdles, respectively.

ST. CHARLES, which won the state Class D title only last Saturday at Mt. Pleasant, scored 58 points to runnerup Ann Arbor St. Thomas' 31 and St. Theresa's 30.

Steve Hurley aided St. Charles' victory with a record 4:41.1 in the mile. He also ran a leg of the winning mile relay that was timed in a record 3:41.5.

Next fall St. Charles will merge with St. Catherine as a multiple parish high school.

FIVE RECORDS were set and another equaled in the Second Division.

Other record performances were by St. Vincent's Wally Crawford in the 880 (2:03.4) and St. Charles' mile relay. Mike Christopher, of Our Lady of Sorrows, tied the high jump mark of 5 feet, 11 inches. The First Division champion-
