

Pontiac Prep 1st in Hurdles

SACRAMENTO, Calif.— Bill Tipton, star hurdler from Pontiac (Mich.) Central high school, captured both the 120-yard high hurdles and 180-yard low hurdles here Saturday night in the nation's top schoolboy invitational meet.

Tipton set a meet record of 18.3 seconds in winnings the low hurdles around a curve. The national high school mark on a straightaway is 18.1.

He also equaled the national mark of 13.4 seconds in the high hurdles but the performance was wind-aided and cannot count as a record.
