

Title Taken By St. Clair

ECORSE (AP)—Pontiac Central grad Bill Tipton showed his stuff over the weekend as he paced the St. Clair Shores Track Club to a runaway victory in the Michigan AAU Junior-Senior Track and Field Meet.

St. Clair Shores piled up 101 points in the meet, held Saturday at Ecorse High School. The Eastern Michigan Track Club finished second, far behind with 41½ points. The Berkley Recreation Club placed third with 37.

Tipton was the junior 120-yard high hurdles in :14.2, short of his :14.1 national high school record. He also took the junior 220-yard dash in :22.1.

Times at the meet were generally undistinguished as cool temperatures and brisk winds held the runners down.

Steve Rosen of the St. Clair Shores club won the junior high jump with a leap of 5'9½" and captured the senior intermediate hurdles unopposed.

The only other double winner was Phil Williams of Eastern Michigan. He took the senior 100-yard dash in :09.9 and won the senior 440-yard dash in :49.1.

Ken House led St. Clair Shores to a 1-2-3-4 sweep of the junior three-mile run with a time of 15:06.

Other team scores were: Detroit Track Club, 32; Wayne State Track Club, 23½; Motor City Striders, 13; Ann Arbor Track Club, 11; Down River Track Club, 6.
