

St. Clair Races To Track Victory

The St. Clair Shores Track Club, getting a big lift from hurdler-sprinter Bill Tipton, captured the Michigan AAU Junior and Senior track and field championships Saturday at Ecorse High School.

Tipton, the former national hurdles champion from Pontiac Central High, won both the junior high hurdles in :14.2 seconds and the junior 220-yard dash in :22.2. He also performed on the St. Clair Shores relay team which finished second to Berkley Recreation in the 880-yard event.

High-point scorer of the meet was Phil Williams of the Eastern Michigan Athletic Club who won both the senior 100-yard dash and 440-yard dash and finished second in the 220 for 13 points.

St. Clair Shores won with 101

points followed by Eastern Michigan AC 41½, Berkley Recreation 37, Detroit Track Club 32, Wayne Track Club 23½, Motor City Striders 13, Ann Arbor Track Club 11 and Down River Track Club 6.
