

Vikings' Wallace Has a Field Day

William Wallace had a field day Tuesday at Southwestern in the Michigan AAU track and development meet

The Northern High speedster won the high hurdles, long jump and 220 and finished second in the 100-yard dash.

He was picked as the most outstanding junior boy, ahead of Central's Herb Washington who nipped Wallace in the 100 in meet record time of 9.7 seconds. Washington also pushed Wallace to a record of 21.9 in the 220.

In the senior division, Pontiac's Bill Tipton added another record to his growing list of track laurels by winning his specialty, the 120 high hurdles in 14.2 seconds which clipped five-tenths of a second of the old mark set by Bob Steele of Plymouth in 1964.

Matthew Jackson of the Ann Arbor Track Club was chosen most outstanding competitor in that division.

Jackson won the 100 and 220 dashes in record times to edge Paul Olmstead of the Berkley Track Club. Olmstead won the two-mile and mile events.

Former Davison star Don Kutchev won the shot put and discus events.

Mary Hokanson outran Lincoln Park's Pam Bacian in the 100 and 440 to earn top honors in the girls' division
