

Local Gals Triumph in Track Meet

CHICAGO — Two members of the Lansing Lightningettes girls' track team were among the stars of the Mayor Daley Invitational Track Meet, held here Friday.

Sprinter Mary Dudley captured first place in one event, and placed in two others. Her victory came in the 440-yard dash, in which she clocked 61.8 seconds. She was fourth in the 220-yard dash and fifth in the 100-yard dash.

Anna Payne won the shot put event with a throw of 28-feet even. Nine other girls competed. The winning effort was also Anna's only throw, and came in a warm-up for the main event. Immediately after the warm-up, a cloudburst hit and tornado warnings were issued, forcing the cancellation of the remainder of the event.

Dawn Rutledge also scored for the Lightningettes, placing fifth in the 220-yard dash, right behind Mary Dudley.

The meet, held at Rockne Memorial Stadium in Chicago, featured some of the outstanding feminine track stars in the nation.
