

Tipton Leads Michigan to Jaycee Title

DES MOINES—Michigan wor the National Jaycee Track and Field championship Saturday at Drake University with 59 points to 23 for runnerup California.

Pontiac's Bill Tipton, freshman-to-be at Eastern Michigar University, led the Michigan assault with meet record times in winning the 120-yard high and 180-yard low hurdles.

Tipton, a Pontiac Central High graduate, was named the meet's outstanding athlete after a 13.4 clocking in the highs and 18.4 in the lows.

Five other boys placed for points. Detroiters Reggie Bradford was fifth in the 440 and Rodney Mack was fifth in the triple jump.
