

Washington Sprints To 60-Yard Victory

KALAMAZOO — Flint Central High's Herb Washington, representing the Indian Track Club, won the 60-yard dash in 6.3 Saturday in the Western Michigan University Invitational Indoor Track Meet. The meet was sponsored by the U.S. Track and Field Federation in the varsity and club division.

Washington was followed by Western Michigan's Tom Randolph, holder of the Mid-American Conference record for 100 meters, Henry Williams, Bowling Green sprinter who has ran the 100 in 9.4, Matt Jackson of the Ann Arbor Track Club and Steve Goldston, Chicago Track Club.

The victory qualifies Washington to participate in the U.S. Track and Field Federation Invitational in Madison Square Garden on Feb. 10.

Other Flint finishers were Ed Watkins, 12th Street Track Club, first in the 60-yard novice dash, Skip Logan, former Northwestern High student running for the Indian Club was fifth in the 60-yard novice low hurdle and Ken Johnson, Indian Club, was fifth in the 600-yard novice dash.
