Francie Kraker Is Off To Chile

MEXICO CITY — With the conclusion of the Olympic games most of the American athletes have returned home but not so Ann Arbor's Francie Kraker.

Miss Kraker left the Olympic Village in Mexico City yesterday. But instead of heading north she began traveling south—to Chile.

With a group of three other American women, Miss Kraker has been invited by the government of Chile to compete and give track exhibitions.

In the 800-meter trials here, Miss Kraker was in a fast heat and finished fifth. The top four runners in each heat advanced. The other two 800-meter heats were won in slower times than Miss Kraker posted.

Other members of the American group going to Chile are hurdlers Mamie Rollins and Pat Vanwolvolaere and Doris Brown, an 800-meter finalist.
