

800 Athletes Entered in U-M Relays

ANN ARBOR—A field of 800 track and field entries from throughout the middle west will compete in the annual USFFT-sanctioned University of Michigan Relays in Yost Field House Friday and Saturday.

Friday's program, limited to the novice division, will start at 5:30 p.m., with competition in the shotput, high jump, pole vault, long jump and triple jump. Trials and semifinals in the hurdles and the 60-yard dash will follow, with finals in other events as well as the mile, 2-mile, 440, 660 and the mile relay, starting at 7:30 p.m.

Twenty events for universities, colleges and clubs will

comprise Saturday's program starting with the long jump at 1 p.m. Other afternoon competition includes both the 65 yard high and low hurdles trials as well as trials in the 60 yard dash and triple jump.

The evening program will open at 6 p.m., with the high jump and pole vault, followed by the shotput. Finals in afternoon events as well as in the 600 and 1,000 yard runs, mile and 2-mile are scheduled along with such relays as the distance medley, sprint medley, two-mile and mile relays as well as the shuttle hurdle event.

Among strong teams participating are Michigan, Michigan State, Eastern Michigan, Western Michigan, Bowling Green and Ohio University.

A strong field will feature the 60-yard dash. This includes such sprinters as Tom Randolph of Western Michigan, with an :06.1 mark; Emmett Taylor,


Ohio U., who boasts the same time as well as the NCAA outdoor 440-yard title; Henry Williams, Bowling Green and Herb Washington of Flint. Washington defeated both Williams and Randolph in the Western Michigan Relays last week.

Individual standouts include Larry Midlam, Michigan, winner of both high and low hurdles in the Kalamazoo meet; Bill Barrett, Eastern Michigan polevaulter, who has cleared 16'6", and Jim Doian, Wolverine two miler, who raced 9:00.4 to break former Michigan star Don McEwen's mark of 9:04, set in 1952.
