Washington Leads Field

CLEVELAND — Flint Central's Herb Washington beat a collegiate field in 5.3 seconds Friday night to win the 50-yard dash in the 28th Knights of Columbus Track Meet at the Cleveland Arena.

Washington, state champion in the 100 and 220-yard dashes, also ran 5.3 in the preliminaries where he defeated Russia's Vladislav Sapeja.

Among his victims in the finals were Tom Randolph of Western Michigan and Bill Heard of Notre Dame.

Washington's time was one-tenth of a second off the meet record held by Frank Budd and Paul Drayton, both former members of the United States Olympic team.
