

'Francie' Captures Second

TORONTO — An overflow crowd of more than 16,000 persons watched Ann Arbor's Francie Kraker and world's mile champion Doris Brown of Seattle battle it out in the half mile with the Seattle distaff runner defeating the Michigan student on a 2:11.11 clocking.

Miss Kraker was runnerup on a 2:12.8 time, good enough to defeat Abby Hoffman, world indoor record-holder while fourth went to Shelley Marshall of New York.

Janis Brown, formerly employed at an Ann Arbor bank and now living in Blissfield, finished third in the 50-yard hurdles on a judge's decision. She was timed in :06.8 with Mamie Rallins of Chicago, Pan-American Games winner, while Sherrie Sherrard won the event on a :06.7 and fourth went to Canada's Jenny Meldrum, a silver medalist in last year's Pan-Am games.
