

Greene Ties Dash Record

MILWAUKEE, Wis. (AP) — Charlie Greene tied the U.S. indoor record in the 50-yard dash and Wisconsin's Mike Butler tied the national mark in the 50-yard high hurdles at the Milwaukee Journal Indoor Track Meet Saturday night.

Greene, a former Nebraska star now running unattached, flashed across the finish line in :5.1 to nip 17-year-old Herb Washington of Flint, Mich., and equal a record set by Penn State's Barney Ewell in 1959.

Butler defeated Charles Pollard of Michigan State with a time of :5.9 in the short-distance high hurdles. His time matched the American record set by Hayes Jones of Eastern Michigan in 1960.
