Trackmen Bring DeWitt High Its First State Athletic Championship

MT. PLEASANT — DeWitt High School won its first state athletic championship here Saturday, taking the Class C track and field honors with 41 points.

Coach Bill Dillingham's Panthers won the title without taking a first place in any event.

Dillingham's team easily won the Central Michigan Athletic Conference meet recently by scoring 73 points. The second-place team had only 29 points.

It was the second straight Class C state title for the CMAC. Last year, Laingsburg took state honors.

Akron-Fairgrove was second with 31 points. Lansing Boys Training School finished in a tie for fifth place with 21 points. Jim Holmes, Vocational School sprinter, won both dashes. He paced the 100-yard dash in 16.1 seconds and the 220 in 22.3 seconds.

DeWitt picked up points in seven events, including two relays. The Panther quartet of

Jack Faught, Mike Doiby, Ed Fosnight and Steve Markham finished third in the mile relay and Brian Wood, Lynn Green, Roger Kaminski and Fred Mazur placed second in the mile event.

Mazur earned points for the CLASS C Long Jump—4, Roger Kaminski (DeWitt) 100 Relay—2, DeWitt; 4, Boy Training Mile—3, Tom Hendricks, (Williamston) 80-Yard Run—4, Steve Markham (DeWitt) 400-Yard Run—3, Ed Fosnight (DeWitt) 7, Bruce Babburn (Pewamo-Westphalia) 100-Yard Dash—4, Fred Mazur (DeWitt) 220-Yard Dash—3, Fred Mazur (DeWitt) Pole Vault—3, DeWitt; Mike Vauts—3, Randy VanSickle (Fulton-Middletown)

state champions in the two dashes. He finished second to Holmes in the 220 and ran sixth in the 100. Fosnight also had a third-place in the quarter-mile and Markham was fourth in the 800-yard run. DeWitt scoring was completed by a sixth-place finish in the long jump by Kaminski.

Besides Holmes' points, Boys Vocational placed sixth in the 800-yard relay. Fulton-Middletown tied for 26th spot with seven points on

Randy VanSickle's second in the pole vault. Bath was 29th with six points on Warren Baird's third-place in the low hurdles. Bruce Babburn was seventh in the 440 to give Pewamo-Westphalia two points and 53rd place. Williamston had one point on Tom Hendricks eighth-place finish in the mile.
