Anita Lee, 10, Detroit TC, continues to dominate the jumping records in the Michigan Association. Anita established a new American high jump record for 10/11 year olds with a height of 4'7% in the recent Midland Relays on June 15.

At this same meet she also captured the long jump with a winning distance of 15'4 which bettered her previous individual best and lists her among the top in the country. Along with her jumping, Anita's running events include 6.9 (50y), 9.6 (75y), 30.1 (220y) and 67.0 (440y).

Anita holds the American record for nine year olds in the high jump with a 4'4 performance. Coach John Lee, her father, predicts great things for this fine athlete in the future. Anita will be looking forward to establishing new records in this same division next year. (From Mike Taylor)
