

Three Records Set In Girls' Track

Two-hundred-fifty girls from 11 of the 16 city elementary schools participated in the City Elementary Girls' Track Championship Wednesday at C. W. Post Field.

Competition was divided into a senior division for sixth grade girls and a junior division for fifth grade girls with many classes in each event in each division. Ribbons were presented to the top participants.

Three records were set. Darlene Bradley of Ann J. Kellogg ran the 75 yard dash in 10.4 seconds in the junior division.

Two girls tied to break the old junior division long jump record of 11 feet 2 inches. Sue Van Denburg of Dudley and Anita Wilson of Franklin both went 11-9.

In the junior division softball throw, Valarie Laurer of U r b a n d a l e broke the old record of 126 feet when she tossed the ball 126 feet 4 inches.
