

# Michigammes Place Second In Region Six

The Michigammes are marking the dates "Aug. 14-17" carefully on their calendars. It's the time for the National Women's AAU Track Championships in Aurora, Colo.

Ann Arbor finished second in the Region Six Championships at Champaign, Ill., with a 57-point total. The meet was won by the Mayor Daley Youth Foundation of Chicago.

The Michigammes had only four entrants.

Francie Kraker won the mile in 5:06, winning by a 50-yard margin.

"If Francie had anyone to make her run, she could have bettered five minutes," Coach Ken Simmons said. "She also won the 880-yard run in 2:14.6 which was very good time considering Francie had run in the mile."

Pressuring Miss Kraker in the 880 was Nancy Shafer of Canton, O., a member of the United States team last year.

Liz Caldwell celebrated her 16th birthday by winning two events, the 100-yard dash in :10.8 and the 220-yard dash in :24.5.

Louise Garrish took a second in the javelin throw with a 160-foot-2-inch effort. Susan Dudley gained second place in the 440-yard run at :57.7.
