

## Michigan Repeats as Track Champ

EUGENE, Or e. — Michigan successfully defended its title here Saturday in the United States Jaycee Junior track and field championships winning four firsts and a second and pilots of the second states and second second

ing up 48 points.
Louisiana was second with 34 points while California and Washington tied for third with 32 points. Thirty-eight states participated in the meet.

Larry Biskner, Michigan high school pole vault cham-pion from Waterford, won his specialty with a leap of an even 15 feet. Other Mcihigan winners were John Morrison, Willie Polk and John Mann.

Morrison, a senior at Redford Union High, won the 120-yard high hurdles in :14.3 seconds; Polk, from Flint Northern, captured the 100-yard dash in 10 seconds flat while Mann, of Farmington, won the high jump with a leap of 6 feet 7 inches. Bob Woodroof, of Rochester, picked up a second for Michigan in the 220-yard dash.
