1969 FINAL CROSS COUNTRY RUN RESULTS

There were two Final Cross Country Runs again this year. On October 25, the Upper Peninsula Final Cross Country Run was held at Northern Michigan University, Marquette. The Lower Peninsula Final Cross Country Run was held at Eastern Michigan University, Ypsilanti, November 1.

There were nine Regional Cross Country Runs each in Classes A and B. The Class C-D schools were assigned to six Regional Runs from which they also

qualified to the Final Run.

At the Lower Peninsula Final Run the Class A team championship was won by Ann Arbor-Huron High School with 120 points. Flint-Kearsley with 142 points, and Pontiac-Northern with 156 points, were second and third, respectively. Douglas Brown of Harper Woods-Notre Dame was first-place finisher with a time of 9:58.7. David Eddy of Adrian was second and Michael Parrett of St. Joseph was third.

There were 86 participants in the Class A Individuals Run. This Run was won by Michael Goodwin of Jackson-Parkside with a time of 10:01.5. Following the winner were Steve Moffet of Pontiac-Waterford Township and Michael Brown

of Grand Rapids-Ottawa Hills.

The team championship in Class B was won for the second straight year by Charlotte with 58 points, followed by Detroit-East Catholic with 127 points and Rochester-Adams with 134 points. The first-place winner was James Goodfellow of Oxford with a time of 10:00.5. William Chenoweth of Charlotte was in second place, Michael Woods of Plainwell won the Individuals Run with a time of 10:16.9.

East Jackson High School repeated as Class C-D Champions by compiling a low total of 123 points. Battle Creek-St. Philip placed second with 198 points and Litchfield placed third with 238 points. Dennis Valentine of East Jackson High School finished first in Class

C-D with a time of 10:11.6.

At the Upper Peninsula Final Run twelve teams were entered in the Class A-B Run, Ishpeming with 47 points again placed first. Menominee was second with 78 points. Paul Williams of Newberry was the first-place winner

with a time of 10:39.

Seventeen teams competed in Class C-D. Rudyard High School won the team championship with 77 points followed by Pickford High School with 81 points. Fred Teddy of L'Anse was the first-place finisher with a time of 10:43.
