

Bentley Tracmen Impress Visiting Relay Rivals

Bentley played the perfect host Saturday . . . that is if you're a Bentley fan.

The Bulldogs piled up 118 1/2 points to run away with their third annual relays meet in a seven-team field.

Lakeville was a distant second with 67 points followed by Hamady 56 1/6 St. John Vianney 47, Holy Rosary 38, Holy Redeemer 37 1/2 and Atherton 6.

MERT Wallace's runners got off to a great start by winning three of the first six events. They had 55 out of a

possible 60 points then while Lakeville was second with 21.

The Bulldogs won nine of 14 events.

Ron Maygar, Dave Elkins, Randy Snider and Terry Travis ran on three winning relay teams while Maygar and Snider grabbed 10 points apiece in field events.

MAYGAR took the high jump with a 5-8 leap while Snider was the meet's top long jump with a 19-7 3/4 showing.

Of the 10 running events in which Bentley didn't rule, Lakeville, St. John Vianney

and Holy Rosary earned trophies.

Lakeville won the sprint medley with a 2:36.8 time with Dan Severn, Rick Banyas, Rich Averill and Stacey Husted forming the team.

Pat Shanahan, Gary Trepanier, Phil Lewis and Ron Groulx led Holy Rosary to the middle distance relay title with a 6:16 clocking while St. John Vianney, behind Jim George, Perry McCord, Bob Patton and Gary Chisholm, won the mile relay at 3:38.6.

LAKEVILLE'S Averill finished second in the pole vault and pushed winner Don McMonagle of Hamady who soared to 12-6.

Both made 11-3, but Averill bowed out at 11-6 while McMonagle needed three attempts to clear. But the Hamady ace went over 12, 12-3 and 12-6 on his first attempts. With the pole set a 13, McMonagle nearly cleared it on the first go but tripped the bar off on his way down.

Holy Rosary's Richard Matts won the shot with a 37-foot heave. But Bentley picked up 20 points with Mike Alexander grabbing second, Milt Weatherhead third and Tom Edwards fourth.

Terry Princing, Dave Brockway, Dave Nagengast, Ron Ledyard, Mike Bary and Jim Penney aided Bentley on the relays as did Harold Brock, Dan Osman, Cliff Best and Carl Ladd.
