

Frankenmuth Wins 'C' At Gavel Club

CASS CITY — Flint Kearsley easily ran off with overall team honors in the 11th annual Gavel Club Relays here Saturday.

In winning the high point trophy for a fourth consecutive year, Kearsley piled up 72 points, and its track team members established two of the three new records set.

Bob Bonnell ran the 440-yard dash in :52 seconds, erasing the :52.3 standard set in 1966 by Akron-Fairgrove's Gordon Aldrich.

Kearsley's other record setting performance came in the 400-meter relay which they won in 2:34.25, wiping out the 1968 mark of the Bay City John Glenn 2:34.5.

A field of 23 teams competed in the relays, and two other trophies were awarded, both for the first time. West Bloomfield won the trophy going to the Class B team with most points and Frankenmuth of the Thumb B Conference won the trophy going to the Class C entry scoring most points.

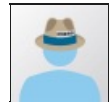
West Bloomfield was a distant second to Kearsley with 28 points. Mount Morris had 26, as Frankenmuth 21, Yale 15½, Bay City John Glenn had 20.

Frankenmuth's mile relay team won the event in 3:38.2 and Yale's Pete Michelz won the long jump with an effort of 20-feet-10.

Mount Morris eclipsed the 1959 880-yard relay mark of 1:34.0 set by Frankenmuth in 1959 with a 1:33.5 clocking.
