

# Kearsley Wins Davison

Kearsley High's track team atoned for a second-place finish in last week's Big Nine Conference track meet by breezing to victory in the seventh annual Davison Relays Monday night.

Don Marsh's Hornets piled up 66 2/3 points and set records in four relay races.

Port Huron Northern was second with 47 points. Then came Clawson (44), Wayne John Glenn (38 2/3), Davison (34 2/3), Clio (25), Milford (23), Beecher (18), Flushing (16) and Mt. Morris (14). Lakeville field to score.

Kearsley shared the title with Grand Blanc last season and won in 1963, 1966 and 1967.

The first record to fall was the two-mile relay where the Horney quartet of Mike Brunet, Brad Lalonde, Ron Yuille and Terry Stewart raced to an 8:13 clocking. The old record of 8:13.5 was set last year by Grand Blanc.

Next, Kearsley's Jim Bonnell, Mike Coates, Kent Raysin and George Geisenhaver went 10:52.9 in the distance

medley to erase the Davison mark of 10:55.3 set last season.

Dave Hoover, Jeff Dosh, Joe Klobuchar and Nels Abramson had a 1:32.1 clocking in the 880 relay for another Kearsley record. Kearsley had the former mark of 1:32.5 in 1963.

Kearsley's final mark came in the 440 relay where Klobuchar, Hoover, Dosh and Abramson won in 44 seconds. Davison had the former mark of 45.1.

The meet's other record came in the spring medley won by Milford in 2:30.8. Ken Velzy, Tom Necomb, Tom Hammil and Mike Sutton made up that contingent.

Kearsley received another first in the pole vault where Mike Boyce and Mark Janowak combined for a 25-foot, 3-inch effort.

Wayne John Glenn won the shot at 97-10, Clio the high jump at 12 feet, Clawson the shuttle hurdles in 59.2, and Davison the mile relay in 3:30.2

Monday night's meet was postponed from Saturday,

May 10, because of bad weather.
