

Pioneer Thinclads Tie For Second

ALBION — The Pioneer High track team left the Albion Relays with a big, golden trophy

after finishing in a second place tie with Birmingham Groves in Section One.

Pioneer and Groves wound up with a 30-point team total while Battle Creek Central won the section on just a few more points, 32½.

So maybe the Pioneers and Bearcats will have a score to settle when they tangle in an all-important Six-A League dual meet at 4:30 p.m. Tuesday in Battle Creek.

The Huron High team turned in a very respectable performance by finishing fourth in Section Two. This division was won by Jackson Parkside with 30½ points.

Newman was also third in the 440-yard dash on :50.4 despite the fact that he pulled a muscle in the race. Skip Burck took a third in the two-mile run at 10:17. Schoch ran his best time in the 880 finishing fourth on 1:50.8.

Russ Kennedy was fourth in the 100-yard dash at :10.1 and fifth in the 220-yard dash on :23.9. Palmer Schoch was fourth in the mile run on his best ever, 4:31.4.

The 880-yard relay team of Bill Twining, Heinonen, Ken Mitchell and Kennedy was fifth on 1:33.2.

In the field events, Newman was second in the long jump at 21 feet 3 inches. Maurice Reese was second in the shot put at 31 feet 1 inch. Dick Evans took a third in the pole vault at 12 feet 6 inches while Pete Schmeberger was fourth in the shot at 47 feet 7 inches.

The Hurons captured a first place in the 880-yard relay as the team of Lynn Hunt, Mike Campbell, Dave Cook and George Russell stopped the watches in 1:22.5.

The squad started off in fine fashion by taking a third in the two-mile run by Scott Hubbard and fourth in the same event from Eddie Fisher.

Mel Arnet got a third in the high jump at 5 feet 9 inches and Charles Wunoch gained a fifth place in the shot put with a toss of 46 feet ¼ inches.

George Russell placed second in both the 100 and 220-yard dashes and the mile relay squad of Hunt, Chuck Hogan, Campbell and Cook was fourth.

M Overpowers Iowa, Drake

IOWA CITY — Larry Midlam tied the track record and broke a Michigan varsity record in the 120-yard high hurdles as the Wolverines piled up 93 points to win a triangular meet from Iowa and Drake.

Drake had 58½ points and Iowa 58.

Midlam had a time of :13.7 in the hurdles which betters the mark of :13.8 set by Bennie McRae, now with the Chicago Bears, in 1961 and tied by Midlam last year.
