# IN FEDERATION MEET

## Waldo Stadium Records Tumble

Three Waldo Stadium marks fell and a fourth was tied Friday in the Michigan Federation Track and Field Championships, a classic event that preceded the Champion of Champions' meet on Memorial Day.

Michigan State's mile relay team sped the course in 3:11.5. Brian Oldfield of the Chicago Track Club unloaded a 63-foot, 10 1/2-inch shot toss and Don Rencher covered 50 feet, 3/4 inch in the triple jump for stadium records.

Mike Bowers of the Ann Arbor Track Club tied the Stadium mark in the high jump with a clearance of six feet, 9 3/4 inches. Entered in the same event was Ron DeVries of Eastern Michigan who last year set a Champion of Champions' standard while competing for Erie Mason on a jump of six feet, 9 1/4 inches.

## Williams Sets Doster Pace

Virgil Williams battled Charlie Mitchell to a standoff, both with 78s, but captured low net honors with his 71 in Class A Memorial Day sweepstakes play at Lake Doster.

Class B winners were John Cross, low gross of 79, and Cross and Bill Thomas with net scores of 66. Bill Moomaw with an 84 and 65 won both gross and net in "C", while low putt winners were Joe Chapel, Class A with 30, Dick VanderKlok, Class B with 30, and Bob Cox in "C" with 31.

Among the guests, Dave Llewellyn fired a 76 to win low gross laurels, William J. VanEck had a net of 72 along with a low putt count of 28, Bill Rhuland won the long drive contest and Larry Bowerman the approaching contest. Among the club members, Tom DenOtter was long drive winner, and Fred Wilsj was closest to the 12th hole.
