

Cramp Ruins Finale

Luck ran out on Larry Williams Monday night in the 10th annual Oakland County Track championships but his brother Gary found reason to celebrate.

Larry, one of the state's finest two-milers developed a cramp in the arch of his foot and had to pull out of his race on the sixth lap. It was a dis-

appointing conclusion to a fine schoolboy career for Larry.

Half an hour later, however, Gary came back to win the mile on a soft and rain-swept track at Southfield High. Gary closed around the oval in 4:27.6.

THE MEET'S only double winner was Dave Anderson of Birmingham Groves who won

both the 100 and 220. Kevin Reade of Waterford Kettering, the state Class A 880-yard champion, won his Specialty in 1:56.8.

The team title went to co-champions Hazel Park and Pontiac Central each of whom piled up 49 points. Birmingham Groves third with 34½, Brother Rice fourth with 32 and Ferndale fifth with 21.
