

Oakland Track Club Runs Wild

HAMILTON, Ont. — Relay teams from the Oakland County Track Club won five events, setting two Canadian records in the process, in the Ontario Relays Sumday at McMasters University.

Keyin Reabe, the Michigan high school half-mile champion from Waterford Kettering, ran on three winning units, including both record-setters.

Reabe anchored Mike Shepherd, Ian Redpath and Bob Woodroof to a record 3:26 in the junior sprint medley (one mile) and also finished up for Shepherd, Kevin Keating and Woodroof as they clocked 3:17.7 in the junior men's mile relay.

The juvenile 440 for 16- and 17-year-olds went to Oakland's Bob Strauch, Reabe, Mike Van Zandt and Shepherd in a record 43,7 seconds.

A team composed of Steve Strauch, Roger Eddy, Woodroof and Redpath won both the open men's 440 in 41.5 and the open 880 in 1:28.7.
