

C.C. Takes # 2 Spot in Conference

The Laker cross country team marked their 3rd straight winning season this year in compiling a 7-4 mark. Tom Laman, senior captain of the squad, was the leading runner with sophomores Dan Harring (who holds the Crockery course record) and junior Ken Zimmerman close behind. Finishing out the top five were Larry Arndt and Mike Roach. The whole team worked very hard, and the competition within the squad was strong throughout the year. The Lakers gathered a 5th at the Northview Invitational, a 4th at the Ludington Invitational, and a 5th at the Regional meet, which was held on the Lakers' home course. In the important conference meet, Spring Lake came in a close second behind Ludington, with Tom Laman (4th) and Dan Harring (5th) making the all-conference team.
