

Ypsilanti Cindermen Turn Back Belleville

BELLEVILLE — Belleville's Garrade Pettus had been getting a lot of publicity as his team's "20-point man." Pettus set a record in the high jump at the Mansfield Relays and was regularly winning the high jump, long jump and hurdles events.

Ypsilanti's Ron Gardner put a stop to that yesterday. Gardner took both hurdles events from Pettus to help the Braves to a 69-49 victory over Belleville.

"Gardner decided to get 10 of those 20 points," said Ypsilanti Coach Levi Simpson. His efforts, plus wins in the 100- and 220-yard dashes by George Huxley, helped put Ypsilanti over the top as the Braves evened their dual-meet record at 1-1.

Ypsilanti winners were John Hunt (shot put, 43-2), Mark Taylor (880, 2:06.2), Gardner (high hurdles, :15.3; low hurdles, :20.5), Huxley (100, :10.4; 220, :24.5), David Smith (440,

:52.70), the mile relay team (Dave Smith, Dane Fortney, Lonnie Taylor, Lurie Davis, 3:41.7) and the 880 relay team (George Huxley, Doug Baylis, Jeff Johnson, Eric Lewis, 1:34.8).
