Pioneer Relay Unit Sets Another Mark

FLINT—Ann Arbor Pioneer High's crack two-mile relay team has added another impressive victory.

Greg Chase, Dan Johnson and twin brothers Lincoln and Palmer Schoch raced home first last night against some tough competition in the Mott Relays. Their time was a record-setting 8:16, not spectacular except that the conditions were miserable—"hurricane-like" winds and cold.

Johnson had a fast 2:01 leg for the Pioneer unit which just a few days ago captured first in the prestigious Manfield Relays.

Pioneer's eight-mile relay team (Skip Burck, Bob Jones, Pete Murtaugh and Tom Hughes) placed third and the mile relay (Rick Mial, John Tyner, Lincoln Schoch and Palmer Schoch) fourth. Maurice Reese and Dave Curby made up the shot put relay unit which placed fourth.
