

MSD, New Haven Pace C-D

It was run at a new site, but Saturday's Class C-D track regional at Guy V. Houston Stadium still had a familiar look.

The same two teams, MSD (Class C) and New Haven (Class D) won the meet as they did a year ago at Dort Field.

MSD won its third straight team title and seventh in nine years by a margin of 4 1/2 points against 39 for Ulica St. Lawrence. New Haven won its second straight Class C crown with 38 points to outdistance runnerup Bendle with 27.

ED ROBINSON ONCE again was the star for MSD. He won both sprints for the third straight year and also helped MSD to a fourth place in the 880 relay.

Uncle Sam's Best Is Ninth Place

WIESBADEN, Germany (AP) — Ninth-placed Joe Fargis on Bonte and In My Cap was the top United States rider in the two-horse jump at the International Equestrian Tournament Saturday.

Fellow American Robert Ridland on Fearless and Blue Pan was 10th. Each rider had four faults.

Fargis went round in 94 seconds and Ridland in 104.2.

Neal Shapiro, U.S. on San Lucal was sixth in another event and Bill Steinkraus, U.S., on Fleet Apple placed 10th.

Class D were: Pat Shanahan, Holy Rosary, 880; Al Marshall, Genesee, 440; Dave Hicks, Byron, two mile; Don Winchester, Mt. Morris St. Mary, pole vault; and Tim Shannon, Holy Redeemer, high jump.

BYRON, WHICH finished third with 27 1/2 points, won the 880 relay and Holy Rosary captured the mile relay.

The top three places in each event qualify for the state meet and in addition, MSD and Genesee earned berths in the 880 relay on the basis of their times (1:37.8) despite tying for fourth.

In Class C, Tom Valley of St. Michael was one of three other runners to get into the state meet despite finishing fourth in the regional. He was timed at 10.8 in the 100.

Guy Hazzard of Bendle was the only other area competitor to score two firsts. He won both hurdles easily to lead the Tigers, who challenged New Haven until the last two events, the 220 and mile relay.

THE ROCKET'S Eli Sims captured the 220, his second victory of the meet, and New Haven finished second in the mile relay. The 10 points earned in those two events clinched the team title for New Haven as Bendle was only able to get two.

Bendle's 880 relay team also finished first and Ortonville's Don Bowen (high jump) was the other area Class C victory.

St. Michael, not figured to challenge for the title in Wednesday's Flint Area Parochial Conference meet, outscored a chief FAPC threat, St. Agnes, 11 1/2 - 4. Mike McCann led the Mikes with a second place in the mile.

St. John Vianney, Holy Redeemer and Holy Rosary finished 4-5-6 to give the Flint area strong representation in Class D. St. John totaled 22 points with its best finishes a second and third in the 880.
