THE ROCKET'S Eli Sims captured the 220, his second victory of the meet, and New Haven finished second in the mile relay. The 10 points earned in those two events clinched the team title for New Haven as Bendle was

only able to get two. Bendle's 880 relay team also finished first and Ortonville's Don Bowen (high jump) was the other area Class C victory.

St. Michael, not figured to challenge for the title in Wednesday's Flint Area Parochial Conference meet, out-scored a chief FAPC threat, St. Agnes, 11½-4. Mike McCann led the Mikes with a second place in the mile.

St. John Vianney, Holy Redeemer and Holy Rosary finished 4-5-6 to give the Flint area strong representation in Class D. St. John totaled 22 points with its best finishes a second and third in the 880.
