# Whitmore Lake Wins Class D Regional Meet

**MICHIGAN CENTER** — It was a pretty good day for area high school teams at the Class B and D regional track meets yesterday.

Whitmore Lake won the Class D title with 40 points and will send its 880 relay team and five individuals to the state meet at Big Rapids.

Chelsea finished second to Marshall in the Class B competition and placed four individuals and both relay teams in the state finals at East Lansing. The Bulldogs rolled up 27½ point to 32 for Marshall.

Ypsilanti St. John was sixth with 15 points in the Class D meet and will send two representatives to the state meet.

For the Trojans, Tim Reed won the high jump with a clearance of 5-6, Dan Tachin took the pole vault with a 10-6 effort and Mitch Caskey won the high hurdles in :16.66. The 880 relay

team was clocked in 1:38.9.

Reed also qualified for the state finals by taking second in the 100-yard dash. Dick Grimston's second-place finish in the 220 advanced him to the state meet.

For the Crusaders, Paul Carroll was third in the two-mile run and Ed Daniels was third in the low hurdles. Also scoring points but failing to qualify were Eric Rickleman (fourth, 880), Daniels (fifth, high hurdles), Jim Moyle (fifth, 440) and the mile relay team of St. John's.

Point scorers for Whitmore Lake were Gary Winters (fourth, 440), Doug Bennett (fourth, low hurdles) and Tom Deakin (fourth, two-mile).

Chelsea's representatives in the state event are Larry Gorton, who won the low hurdles in :21.2, Mike McGinn (second in the 880, 2:04.2), Kim Aronson (second, 440, :52.3) and Jim Wojcicki (third, high hurdles, :16.0).

The winning mile relay team of the Bulldogs was clocked in 3:32.5. Its members are Wojcicki, Dan Hoover, McGinn and Aronson. The 880 relay team, whose time for a second-place finish was 1:34.6, includes Gorton, Art Collins, Jeff Hughes and David Porath.

Wojcicki scored points in the pole vault also, tying for fifth with a height of 11-5.
