



Lakeville's Carol Kreiner Clears Last Hurdle in 80-Yard Race

Flushing, Atherton Girls Win

Kearsley may be the Big Nine Conference power in boys' track, but it's all Flushing when it comes to girls' competition.

The Raiders dominated the conference meet Saturday at Kearsley, winning nine of the 12 events and piling up 83½

points. Davison was second with 57½, followed by Kearsley, 29, and Mt. Morris, 1.

THE COUNTY B League girls' meet was also held at Kearsley and went down to the final race before Atherton clinched the championship.

Atherton was tied with Lakeville after the 440-yard relay but won the title by finishing second in the 880-yard medley relay while Lakeville took fifth.

County B team totals were: Atherton 49, Lakeville 46, Montrose 40, Bendle 35 and Bentley 10.

FLUSHING was unbeaten during the season in dual meet competition and it was the Raiders' second straight title under two-year Coach Belinda McPhersen.

Darci Auker of Flushing was the individual star of the Big Nine meet and Bendle's Pam Durand performed similarly in the County B.

Miss Auker won three events and also ran a leg on Flushing's winning 440-yard relay quartet. Darci won the 100-yard dash, the 50-yard dash and the running long jump.

MISS DURAND was the speediest and most durable of the County B girls. She won the 50 and 200-yard dashes and the running long jump.

Her strength was proven in the 880-yard medley relay where she ran the 440-yard anchor portion. Despite trailing the leader by 40 yards

when she took the baton, Pam charged in front within 180 yards and won easily.
