

220 Record Smashed in City League

Marshall Dill of Northern smashed the Detroit City League track record in the 220-yard dash Thursday as Southeastern captured the East Side title with 68 points.

Dill, who also won the 100-yard dash, was timed in 21.6 seconds, one-tenth of a second better than the old mark held by Ken Burnley of Mumford and Rick Cason of King.

Willie Smith paced Southeastern by winning the high hurdles. He also tied for first place in the low hurdles.

Mackenzie, led by Jerry Fulghen, won the West Side Track Meet Thursday, outdistancing runner-up Redford, 120-95. Twelve schools participated in the meet.

Fulghen accounted for 24 of Mackenzie's points, winning the high jump (6-feet, 3-inches), finishing third in the long jump and high hurdles and fifth in the low hurdles.

Ronald Duncan of Mackenzie scored a double win, taking the 100 in 10.1 and the 220 in 22.2.
