

Reabe Runs 4:11.1 Mile At Oxford

Kevin Reabe, the sensational distance runner from Waterford Kettering High, turned in a 4:11.1 mile Saturday night in the Oxford Invitational track meet.

Reabe, who has already signed a tender at the University of Kansas, was 2.1 seconds under the state record of 4:13.2 held by Lou Scott, former Detroit Eastern star.

Mark Freeman, a freshman at Warren Fitzgerald, high jumped six-feet 4-inches to win his event.
