## *On The Move*

MIDLAND — Coach Ken "Red" Simmons has high hopes for four Michigammes in the National Junior Track Championships in St. Louis this weekend.

Simmons' hopes are based on performances in the Midland Invitational Track Meet over the weekend.

Carol Frederick won the mile in 5:13 and placed second in the 880-yard on 2:21 in the 14-17 age group. Ann Forshee ran the 880 in 2:21.4 in the 12-13 age group.

Meanwhile, Wonda Thornton placed second in the 3,000-meter run and the mile run as well as a third in the 880. Kathy

Vidrik placed second in the 12-13 mile on a 5:35.

"Ann and Kathy are now in the first six in the nation in their age groups," Simmons said. "I expect them to do very well. Carol has had quite a setback due to illness, but she seems to be recovering. Wonda should also place well up in the finals."

The Michigammes also got placings from Karen Dungey, who was fourth in the 440-yard hurdles, and Karen McKeechee, who was fifth in the 14-17 mile run. Joan Ludtke was second in the javelin and fourth in the discus while Jamie Richards was first in the shot put and second in the discus.
