

Bernadette Hartfield Tops In Girls Track

Bernadette Hartfield ran wild as she captured first places in three girls' track events to give the girls their first triple event winner in pre-Olympian activities at Filstrup Field Thursday afternoon.

Miss Hartfield reigned supreme in the 10-11 year division. She won the 50-yard dash in 6.7, the 100-yard dash, and the 220 to make a clean sweep of the track events in that division.

In addition, four other girls were able to grab two first places apiece in their respective divisions.

Irene Potts displayed a variety of talents in the 18-and-

over division by winning the 220 yard dash and the shotput with an outstanding throw of 27 feet 2 inches.

Ester Harden had too much speed for the other girls in the 12-13 year division to contend with. Miss Harden won the 100 in 12.9 and the 220 in 30.8.

Polly Partee duplicated the feat in the 16-17 year old division, winning the 100 yard dash in 12.6 and capturing the 220 with a time of 30.8.

Cynthia McGee gave the girls their fourth double winner of the day by winning the 100 in 12.9 and the 220 in 30.3 in the 14-15 year old division.
