

Grand Rapids Youths Win District Olympics

Grand Rapids youngsters claimed 12 first places en route to winning the first West Michigan Junior Olympics District track meet Wednesday at Houseman Field.

Grand Rapids won the title with 206 points while Muskegon edged Wyoming for second place, 167-160. East Grand Rapids was fourth with 91 points.

Wyoming produced the only youngsters who won more than one event. Diane Erdman won the 50-yard dash and the standing long jump in the 8-9-year-old girls class and Kathy Schnieder took both the 75 and 100-yard dashes in the 10-11 girls category.
